Dear Mr. Millen:

When the Detroit Lions drafted Caleb Campbell, the Army policy in effect allowed him to participate in professional sports. He would have served concurrently performing military recruiting duties.

However, a subsequent Department of Defense policy was published that superseded the Army's policy from 2005. Upon detailed review, the Army policy has been revised to align and comply with the DoD policy.

Consequently, 2LT Campbell has been directed to cease full time participation in professional football to perform full time traditional military duties. He may apply for release from his Active Duty Service Obligation in two years (May 2010) to participate in professional sports.

We apologize for any hardship that this causes the Lions, but please be assured that Caleb was allowed to enter the draft in good faith.
