AGREED ORDER TO MODIFY CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the Agreed Order to Modify Conditions of Pre-trial Release, and the Court being fully advised that Assistant State Attorney Elizabeth L. Parker and Michael Salnick, Attorney for Defendant are in agreement and that the victim, Michael Dippolito has been consulted and is also in agreement with this modification, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

- 1. The Defendant in the above referenced case was arrested on August 5, 2009 on the charge of Solicitation to Commit First Degree Murder. The Defendant was placed on House Arrest with a GPS monitor after posting \$25,000 bond.
- 2. The Defendant will continue to remain under strict supervision of the Palm Beach County Sherriff's Office on House Arrest with a GPS monitor with the following conditions:
 - A) The Defendant is to live at her mother's home and be under a 24 hours curfew.
 - B) The Defendant is to remain inside the house and is not allowed to leave even to go outside without permission of the supervising Deputy from PBSO.
 - C) The Defendant is not allowed to work.
 - D) The Defendant is not allowed to have direct, indirect or third party contact with the victim in the case, Michael Dippolito.(a No Contact Order was signed on August 6, 2009)

- E) The Defendant is not allowed to have direct, indirect or third party contact with the witness/CI in the case.
- (a No Contact Order was signed on August 6, 2009)
- F) The Defendant may travel to see her attorney and to any medical appointments with prior approval of the supervising Deputy from PBSO.
- G) The Defendant is to be subjected to random drug testing at her expense.
- H) The Defendant is not to possess or to have access to any weapons.
- The Defendant is to comply with all rules and regulations of the supervising Deputy and the PBSO House Arrest program.
