She reported that Eric Estrena was the father and he picked the baby up at 9:00pm on 08/23/2009. On 08/25/2009 at approximately 3:45am detectives from the Hamilton Police Department located the body of Israel Santos in the garbage located behind the garage at 1341 Shuler Avenue. Eventually Asuncion admitted that the baby was in a bouncy seat in the bedroom of 1341 Shuler #3 crying for an extended period of time and she became upset and grabbed him by the face with both her hands and shook him. After she shook him he became quiet and then quit breathing.

Affiant requests that a Warrant be issued forthwith to permit the search of the above person or premises and says that there is no urgent necessity for the search to be made at night.
