In reference to the above case, the Treatment Team hereby makes the following recommendations concerning Ms. Gray's continued treatment:

- I. Ms. Gray to be transferred to _____ where she will continue her treatment for diagnoses of _____ This facility possesses the expertise and experience to meet her needs on her journey to wellness and is also situated in the _____ away from the press so she will have the privacy necessary to continue the work she has started here at St. Simons by the Sea. The length of their program is 90 days and we feel that she should complete that program. Another area requiring attention during this period is family therapy and liberal visitation with her children. We have been assured by the Director at _____ that family work is part of their program;
- II. After completing the program at _____ we recommend that she participate in an Intensive Outpatient Program for six to eight weeks. One that we know of that is excellent is _____ and is located in Jacksonville;
- III. After completing the IOP, Ms. Gray will continue treatment and therapy with the Doctors Burack for medication management and therapy, individually and with husband, Reid. We will of course defer to the recommendations of _____ treatment team if they think something else would be more appropriate;
- IV. Ms. Gray will be accompanied to _____ by her attorney, Mark R. Miller, and the transfer will happen on Monday, November 16, 2009.

Ms. Gray has completed the _____ program here at St. Simons. While here she was cooperative, followed our directives, took medication as prescribed, and participated in all phases of the program.

Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter shall confirm that Mrs. Gray has been accepted into our facility if the court allows, and that there is an available bed for her at this time. We understand that she has a current legal matter pending in court and **request the importance of leaving our location name and address off of any court documents with the goal of not exposing any of our clients to the press or uninvited visitors. All of our clients are protected under the Health Insurance Portability And Accountability Act of 1996.** The _____ is an extended care adult residential treatment center specializing in substance abuse, Trauma, Mood Disorders and other process addictions. We are licensed by The State of Florida under _____ The average length of stay is 90 days to start, however we have clients who have been with us for over a year.

Our treatment team consists of 15 therapists, all having specialized areas of expertise, 3 case managers, a medical team of registered nurses, a psychiatrist and two medical doctors. Additionally, we have a support staff of house managers and administrative personnel all trained and certified in a variety of treatment services.

We have a very structured program beginning at 6:45am all the way through 10:00pm. Mrs. Gray would be under the care of a primary therapist, a trauma therapist and will be involved with other members of the clinical team throughout the day. Since the work done in this setting is very intensive, the staff to client ratio is 6 clients to a caseload. Our clients are accounted for at all times and do not leave property unless accompanied by a staff member and these outside appointments typically consist of emergency medical appointments or court hearings. We have several therapists remain on property overnight.

Although we will request records from her previous facilities, a full comprehensive assessment will be completed including a psycho-social assessment, a medical history and physical, a psychiatric evaluation and follow-up for medication management for continued stabilization and a trauma assessment. Additional testing and assessments will be determined by our medical and clinical team.

Our Family Week Program is held every 6 weeks and in the interim we are not opposed to this client having supervised visitation with her children . We will continue to follow the recommendations of Dr. Mc Gowan and consult with her after the appropriate releases are signed.

Many of our clients are referred from all over the country as well as other parts of the world. We have had many clients court ordered to our facility and have worked closely with attorneys, courts, parole and probation and other agencies throughout the United States providing open communication and to ensure full compliance.
