EMERGENCY TEMPORARY ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court:

1. That the physical custody of the minor child AJA DANIELLE JOHNSON is hereby placed with the biological father, JOHN JAMES JOHNSON.
2. That this matter be set down on the Emergency Temporary Order Hearing docket.
3. This case will be set for a *Ten (10) Day Hearing* before the Honorable Judge *Larry Show* in the Oklahoma County Courthouse, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, Downtown Oklahoma City, at *9:00* o'clock *A.* M. the *6th* day of *July* 2006, at which time the natural mother may be heard as to the reasons she feels that she cannot or should not comply with this Order and a final ordered entered.


4. That a *temporary restraining order* is hereby entered against anyone interfering with the said custody of the biological father, JOHN JAMES JOHNSON.

JOURNAL ENTRY ON TEN DAY HEARING

This matter coming on for hearing before me, the undersigned Judge of the District Court, on this 6th day of July, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. on Ten Day Hearing on Emergency Temporary Order as entered on the 29th day of June, 2006. Petitioner appears in person and with counsel, John C. Branch, and Respondent appears in person and with counsel, Paula D. Wood. Parties announced that agreement had been reached on all issues and urged the Court to adopt and ratify same, to wit:

1. Parties awarded joint custody of the minor child, Aja Danielle Johnson, with shared parenting and neither mother or alleged father to pay child support to the other alleged parent.
2. Mother and putative Father to have possession of the minor child on alternating weeks, beginning on this date to the Mother and changing to the putative Father at noon next Wednesday; and continuing to alternate each week with possession changing at noon each Wednesday thereafter until further order of this Court.
3. The Receiving Parent shall be responsible to provide transportation for the minor child, and the exchange points shall be the Sheriff's Office at Crossroads Mall in Oklahoma City OK and the Police Department at Davenport, OK, each Wednesday at noon.


4. Genetic testing of the parties shall be done and the Oklahoma Department of Human Services is ordered to assist and schedule same. If putative Father is not correct on his claim of paternity, he shall be wholly responsible to pay those costs or, in the alternative, the Mother shall be solely responsible to pay for the same.

5. Putative Father is ordered to undergo testing for THC and Methamphetamine on this date at his sole expense and the results are to be transmitted to each party or counsel.

6. Oklahoma County Public Defenders Office shall be appointed Guardian *ad litem* for the minor child by order entered separately.


7. This matter is set for Review of Ten Day Hearing at 9:00 a.m. on August 30, 2006.

IT IS SO ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court.

DECREE OF PATERNITY

THIS CAUSE comes regularly on this ^{25th} day of October 2007, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court; the Petitioner appears by and through counsel, JOHN C. BRANCH; and the Respondent appears by and through Counsel, PAULA DAVIDSON WOOD.

The Court, having examined the files and records in this case, having reviewed the results of genetic testing done by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services, and having fully considered the evidence, and being fully advised in the premises, FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

FINDINGS

- 1. That Petitioner is now and has been an actual resident in good faith of the State of Oklahoma for more than six (6) months, and a resident of Oklahoma County for more than thirty (30) days
