EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CUSTODY ORDER

THIS MATTER was set for hearing on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2009, before me the undersigned Judge of the District Court, upon the Emergency Show Cause hearing. The Petitioner appears with counsel, BRYAN W. CADDELL, and the Respondent appears *pro se*. The parties announce the following agreement and the Court approves the same as follows:

1. Emergency custody to Petitioner to remain in full force and effect until further order of the Court.
2. Respondent to have supervised visitation; the parties shall work together on when visitation will take place with the understanding that the Respondent will supervise such visitation.
3. Child shall not be left alone with Respondent; the child shall not be around LESTER HOBBS, Respondent's current husband.
4. Child support shall not be ordered at this time because of Respondent's medical and financial situation and because Petitioner can financially support the minor child on his own; a deviated Child Support Guideline is attached hereto.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court:**


1. That the physical custody of the minor child AJA DANIELLE JOHNSON is hereby placed with the biological father, JOHN JAMES JOHNSON.
2. That this matter be set down on the Emergency Temporary Order Hearing docket.
3. This case will be set for a *Ten (10) Day Hearing* before the Honorable Lisa Hammond in the Oklahoma County Courthouse, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, Downtown Oklahoma City, at 9 o'clock A. M. the 16 day of November, 2009, at which time the natural mother may be heard as to the reasons she feels that she cannot or should not comply with this Order and a final order be entered.



4. That a *temporary restraining order* is hereby entered against anyone interfering with the said custody of the biological father, JOHN JAMES JOHNSON.
5. That the mother personally appears not and should be give notice of the above hearing by way of private process.
