COUNT I (A FELONY):

That on or about the 28th day of March, 2000, at 108<sup>th</sup> Street and Highway 9, in the City of Norman, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, said defendant did drive and operate a certain motor vehicle, to-wit: a 1981 Oldsmobile Delta 88, in Cleveland County, Oklahoma,

COUNT II (A MISDEMEANOR):

Further, that on or about the 28th day of March, 2000, at 108<sup>th</sup> Street and Highway 9, in the City of Norm Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, said defendant did attempt to elude Officer Wishon, a Norman Police Offic Cleveland County, Oklahoma, while in the performance of his duty, in the following manner, to-wit: that the said defendant was then and there operating a motor vehicle on the public streets and roads of Cleveland County, and ha received a visual and audible signal by means of a red light and a siren from said officer, who was then and there dr motor vehicle showing the same to be an official Norman Police car, directing the said defendant to bring his vehicl stop, but that said defendant did then and there wilfully and wrongfully increase his speed, in an attempt to elude sai police officer,
