to reprimand him - well, his
school counselor had told him
if we spanked him to call
911. This was ~~John~~
John Bristine - who is now in
private practice. So, Colt called
911 & his father was arrested!!

Another time I talked to his doctor,
Dahana Wilcox & told her of his
inability to think of what would
happen if he did certain things.
At that time, I asked her to refer

us to a hospital in Bellingham for a brain scan and she refused. That was the closest place to our home for this type of testing. I received no help from the Stanwood/Camano school district even though there were many problems in that area with CBT. I tried for years to get help for him.

Then he started hanging around the wrong type of friends and this made things worse for him. He does NOT do drugs or alcohol and does NOT smoke - all of which I am quite proud of. As far as any firearms, he shot my shot-gun only once and does not like any guns. When he is released from custody, he will be living at my sister's ranch. This is because I don't feel like the Island County Sheriff's will ever leave him alone.

When he was wanted for a

③ failure to appear, they broke into my house and took several items out of his bedroom and then said he stole them. Another time, they knocked on the back door, pushed me aside and searched my house for him, pushing me down - even though I had told Kelly March that Colt was not here.

This boy has had many disappointments all his life.

His step father died and our dog and this had severe effects on Colt and I.
