



Interviews with 1,034 adult Americans conducted by telephone by Opinion Research Corporation on April 29 - May 1, 2011. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points.

The sample also includes 964 interviews among registered voters (plus or minus 3 percentage points).
