On 2/26/12, at approximately 1917 hours, I was dispatch to 1111 Retreat View Cir. in reference to a complainant seeing a suspicious person in the area. While en route dispatch stated they were receiving calls in reference to gun shots being heard in the area where I was responding to.

Ofc. T. Smith stated via radio that he was arriving in the area. Ofc. T. Smith later states that there was one subject shot and he had one at gun point.

Upon arrival Ofc. T. Smith had a white male, later identified as George Zimmerman, in custody. Zimmerman was also the original caller in reference to the suspicious person.

I then noticed that there was, what appeared to be a black male wearing a gray sweater, blue jeans, and white/red sneakers laying face down on the ground. The black male had his hands underneath his body. I attempted to get a response from the black male, but was met with negative results. At that time Sgt. Raimondo arrived and attempted to get a pulse on the black male but none was found. At that time, Sgt. Raimondo and I turned the black male over and began CPR. Sgt. Raimondo did breaths and I did chest compressions.

Sgt. S. McCoy arrived on scene and relieved me continuing compressions. Sanford Fire Rescue arrived on scene and attempted to revive the subject, but could not. Paramedic Brady pronounced the subject deceased at 1930 hours.

The scene was then secured with crime scene tape by Ofc. Mead and Ofc. Wagner. Ofc. Robertson began a crime scene contamination log.

Lt. Taylor arrived on scene and notified dispatch to have Major Crimes respond to the scene.

Ofc. Mead and Ofc. Wagner were able to make contact with neighbors in the area. They were able to obtain statements from all witnesses on scene.

The scene was turned over to SPD Major Crimes.

On 2/26/2012, at approximately 1917 hours, I responded to 1111 Retreat View Cir in reference to a report of a suspicious person. As I arrived on scene, dispatch advised of a report of shots fired in the same subdivision.

I was advised by dispatch that the report of shots fired was possibly coming from 1231 Twin Trees Ln. I was then advised, after receiving multiple calls, that there was a subject lying in the grass in between the residences of 1231 Twin Trees Ln. and 2821 Retreat View Cir. I responded to 2821 Retreat View Cir and exited my marked Sanford police vehicle and began to canvas the area. As I walked in between the buildings I observed a white male, wearing a red jacket and blue jeans. I also observed a black male, wearing a gray hooded sweat shirt, laying face down in the grass.

I asked the subject in the red jacket, later identified as George Zimmerman (who was original caller for the suspicious person complaint), if he had seen the subject. [REDACTED] Zimmerman complied with all of my verbal commands and was secured in handcuffs. Located on the inside of Zimmerman's waist band, I removed a black Kel Tek 9mm PF9 semi auto handgun and holster. While I was in such close contact with Zimmerman, I could observe that his back appeared to be wet and was covered in grass, as if he had been laying on his back on the ground. Zimmerman was also bleeding from the nose and back of his head.

Shortly after securing Zimmerman, Officer Ricardo Ayala arrived on scene. I advised Officer Ayala that I had not made contact with the black male subject laying on the ground. I observed Officer Ayala make contact with the subject and attempt to get a response, but was met with negative results. Shortly after this, other officers began to arrive on scene along with SPD Rescue 38 who began to give aid to the subject laying on the ground.

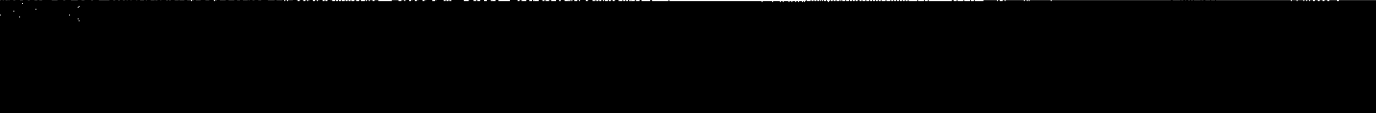

This narrative is a supplemental to my original narrative on 2/27/2012. It should be noted that I was in contact with Zimmerman from the time that I secured him on scene, until the time that he was released from investigative detention.

Zimmerman was treated on scene by SFD for his injuries. Zimmerman was given the opportunity by SFD, while on scene at Retreat View Cir, to be transported to the hospital in order to be examined by a doctor for his injuries. Zimmerman declined.

While en route to the Sanford Police Department with Zimmerman, he complained that his head hurt and that he felt a little light headed. I asked Zimmerman if he would like to go to the hospital. Zimmerman stated that he wasn't sure what to do. I advised Zimmerman that it was his choice, and that I would drive him to the hospital. Zimmerman declined once again to be taken to Central Florida Regional.

Once I arrived at the Sanford Police Department with Zimmerman, he was placed in an interview room. Zimmerman was provided with tissues and a bottle of water. Zimmerman was asked once again if he felt the need to go to the hospital, or if he wanted SFD to come back out to take another look at him. Zimmerman declined and stated "I think I'll be ok."

I kept a constant watch on Zimmerman through two way mirror glass. At no point did Zimmerman exhibit any behaviors that warranted my concern for immediate medical attention.

I also made contact with Zimmerman every 15-20 minutes (approximtely) to check his status, or to see if he had any requests. During my contact with him, Zimmerman only requested for more tissues, more water, and to go to the bathroom. Zimmerman did not make any more complaints about feeling light headed.

On 02-26-12 at approximately 1920 hours, I responded to the area of Retreat View Circle in reference to a disturbance with "shots fired". While enroute I heard Ofc. Smith communicate that he was in contact with a possible suspect and an injured person.

On arrival at the complex, I asked Ofc. Smith if he was left, or right from the entrance. Ofc. Smith told me to go left. After the first turn, I saw Ofc. Smith standing between the buildings with a male. I exited my car and went to Ofc. Smith. Ofc. Smith identified the person in his custody as the "shooter" and showed me a handgun.

As Ofc. Smith escorted the suspect male to his patrol car, I went to render aid to the injured male. I noticed that the injured male was young, and apparently of African-American descent. The male was lying on his stomach with his head oriented in the general direction of north. I attempted to obtain a pulse from this position, but did not get one. With the assistance of Ofc. Ayala, I rolled the male on to his back and tried to get a pulse. At this time I confirmed that the male had no pulse and was not breathing. Ofc. Ayala and I began CPR. As I began breaths I noticed bubbling sounds from the male.

I lifted the males shirt and saw a chest wound. As I lifted the shirt, I felt a large, cold can in the center pocket. I directed bystanders nearby to get me some plastic wrap and Vaseline. An Asian male returned with a plastic grocery bag and I used it to seal the chest wound. I was unable to find an exit wound on the males back.

Sgt. McCoy relieved Ofc. Ayala from chest compressions and she and I performed CPR for approximately six minutes before rescue arrived. Once rescue took over, I stood by and watched until they pronounced the male deceased.

I supervised the establishment of the crime scene and crime scene log. I procured an emergency blanket from my vehicle and covered the male. I assisted with identifying witnesses.

On February 26, 2012, I was notified to respond to the area of Retreat View Circle reference a shooting. I then notified Inv. Singleton to also respond. Upon my arrival and entering the crime scene, I observed a black male, later identified as, Trayvon Martin laying on the ground with his face up with his head to the west. Martin was wearing a grey sweatshirt and light colored shorts and white tennis shoes.

I was told by an officer that a George Zimmerman was the shooter and a hand gun has been recovered. The officer then told me that Zimmerman had been taken to the Sanford Police Department.

I observed a key chain lying on the grass near the T portion of the walkway, a black flashlight lying on the grass just east of the key chain.

I asked the patrol supervisors on scene if they had canvassed the area. I was told they had some statements from witness. I asked the supervisor to have some of the officers to go door to door as far as the crime scene tape in attempt to locate more witness. I asked another patrol officer to run the vehicle tags parked along the road on both sides of the incident. There was a white male standing inside the crime scene standing next to the log officer. I made contact with the subject confirmed we had documented his information and then asked him to exit the crime scene.

I noticed a black cell phone near the area of Martin. I then contacted Agent Shor from CCIB to my location and asked him to bring the cell phone device, a device that is used to down load cell phone information. Upon Agent Shor's arrival he told me that he could not down load any information because the cell phone battery was either very low or the was not operable because the cell phone had gotten wet because of the current weather condition (wet and rain).

While Martin was in the process of being transferred to the M.E's office an inventory was being conducted of Martin's person. I noticed the items collected for evidence were a bag of skittles, an Arizona ice tea can and hand phones. I also observed Sgt. Ciesla recover an empty bullet casing in the grass after Martin's was recovered from the scene.

I responded to the Sanford Police Department upon my arrival I asked Zimmerman's wife to get another set of clothing because the investigators were going to seize her husband's clothes. Zimmerman was released a short time later.

On February 28, 2012 I spoke with SA Carter who told me, we did not need a search warrant. I had CST Smith take the cell phone to the Seminole County Sheriff's Office to see if they could download the cell phone. On March 1, 2012 I was contact by the supervisor from the Seminole County Sheriff's Office that they could not do anything with the cell phone other than download what was on the memory chip because they did not have the password.

On March 2, 2012, I contacted via email and asked Sgt. Ciesla to recover the cell phone back from the Seminole County Sheriff's Office.

 On 02/27/12 I responded, as the on duty Supervisor, to the area of 1111 Retreat View Circle in reference to several calls advising shots fired. As I was enroute, Officer T. Smith, had already arrived. Officer T. Smith advised over 11A that he needed assistance immediately, confirming there was a victim unresponsive and he had one nl gun point.

Upon my arrival, I observed that Officer T. Smith had one subject in custody and seated in the rear of his vehicle. I confirmed that Officer T. Smith was okay and then went to the other assisting Officers, who were attempting to revive the victim. Upon making contact with the officers that were with the victim, I provided a CPR mask to Sgt. A. Raimondo so that he may provide rescue breaths. I put gloves on, placed a plastic bag over the wound to the victim's chest and proceeded to provide chest compressions. Our efforts were continued until SFD arrived and took over. Briefly thereafter, SFD declared the victim deceased.

I instructed Officer T. Smith, to have SFD provide medical care to the suspect, reference visible blood on his face and then to transport the suspect to the SPD, for everyone's safety. I also instructed Officer A. Johnson to accompany Officer T. Smith to SPD, for officer safety. I instructed Officer C. Davila to attempt to locate the victim's identification, to no avail.

The victim is described as a younger B/M, in his teens. I observed a single gun shot wound to his chest. I observed a package of Skittles in the front pocket of the victim's sweatshirt. I observed a can of Arizona Iced Tea and a pair of ear phones, in close proximity to the victim's body. Scattered nearby, I observed a small flash light, cell phone and car keys with a small flash light.

I instructed assisting Officers to go door to door in an attempt to obtain any witness statements. Officer Mend assisted in doing this.

I assured that the crime scene was secured by crime scene tape and that a crime scene contamination log had been started. The scene was held pending the arrival of Major Crimes.

Upon arrival of Investigations staff, Officer R. Aynal provided a briefing and the scene was turned over to them. I had no further involvement in this investigation.

On 02/26/2012 at approximately 1900hrs hrs I responded to Twin Lakes Town Homes located with in the City of Sanford in reference to a call for service involving possible shots being fired. While en route I noted the weather to be raining and the time of day to be dark.

Upon arrival I noted that multiple officers, including my two sergeants were on scene administering first aide and rescue breathing to a black male, later identified as Trayvon Martin.

I gave instruction to my trainee, Ofc N Robertson to assist me in securing the scene with crime scene tape. I then instructed Ofc Robertson to maintain and control the crime scene log after instructing him on how to do so.

As some of the residents gathered to watch the activity taking place, I noticed that Ofc T Smith was still on scene and he had a Latino male, later identified as George Zimmerman in his custody. As the scene came under control, I walked to Ofc Smith's car where Zimmerman was sitting and in handcuffs and used my personal I-Phone (due to an immediate lack of access to a digital camera) to take a picture of Zimmerman's face. I saw that Zimmerman's face was bloodied and it appened to me that his nose was broken. I also saw that the back of Zimmerman's head was also bloodied.

I then walked to where Martin lay on the ground and took a photo of Martin's face as well. I observed no physical injury to Martin. As I maintained the crime scene with Ofc Robertson I assisted with handing out witness statements to those who were willing to cooperate.

Inv. Serino requested my assistance for security to walk with him as he again made contact with all the witnesses who cooperated with police to secure an interview with them. I gave instruction to Ofc Robertson to maintain the crime scene and I assisted Ofc Serino.

After giving Ofc Serino the assistance he needed, I then cleared with Lt M Taylor that the crime scene was secured and that my assistance on scene was no longer needed and that I could return to my regular patrol duties. During the evening I down loaded the photo's to my department issued lap top and deleted the photos from my personal phone.

On 03/18/2012 I received information from Ofc T Smith that no photo existed of George Zimmerman with his injuries. I then emailed both photos to Inv C Serino. Inv C Serino then requested I submit this narrative with my involvement in this case.
