MARKS AND WOUNDS:

Scratch marks of left neck and left upper arm.
 Incised wound of left eyebrow, right neck, left wrist, right forearm and sacro-coccygeal region.
 Abrasions and contusion of left chest, left and right elbow, left wrist, right abdomen, right inguinal region, left knee and left leg.
 Scars of left chest, left upper arm and right leg.
 Stab wounds of right and left chest.

ANATOMIC DIAGNOSES:

1. Stab wound of left proximal third of anterior chest with perforations of left lung.
 - a) Left hemothorax (600 ml).
2. Stab wound of mid third of left anterior chest with perforations of left lung.
 - a) Left hemothorax (600 ml).
3. Stab wound of right anterior chest with perforations of pericardial sac and right hemidiaphragm and penetration of liver.
 - a) Hemoperitoneum (1000 ml).
4. Incised wound of neck with penetration of trachea.
 - a) Blood in lumen of trachea and stomach.
 - b) Cervical soft tissue hemorrhage.
5. Incised wound of posterior trunk (x1), left wrist (x2) and right forearm (x1).
6. Scratch marks of neck and left upper arm.
7. Abrasions of chest and upper extremities.
8. Contusions of left upper extremity, anterior abdomen, right inguinal region and left lower extremity.
9. Subscalpular hemorrhage, right and left parietal regions.
10. Pulmonary edema and congestion.
11. Atherosclerosis of aorta, slight.
12. Scars of left chest, left upper arm and right leg.
13. Post mortem submersion of head, trunk and extremities in water.

CAUSE OF DEATH: STAB WOUNDS OF TRUNK AND INCISED WOUND OF NECK WITH MULTIPLE VISCERAL INJURIES.
