

Interviews with $\mathbf{1 , 0 4 5}$ adult Americans conducted by telephone by ORC International on November 21-23, 2014. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points.

The sample includes 692 interviews among landline respondents and 353 interviews among cell phone respondents.

## METHODOLOGY

A total of 1,045 adults were interviewed by telephone nationwide by live interviewers calling both landline and cell phones. All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect national Census figures for gender, race, age, education, region of country, and telephone usage. Among the entire sample, $28 \%$ described themselves as Democrats, $23 \%$ described themselves as Republicans, and $49 \%$ described themselves as Independents or members of another party
