

OKLAHOMA CITY, Oklahoma (July 21, 2015) – Frontier City's Ride Admission Policy has been developed in consultation with industry professionals based on the recommendations of the ride manufacturer, past experiences, and evaluations of each ride using knowledge of the ride in all operating conditions. Our prime consideration is the ability of each person to endure the dynamics of a ride without risk of injury to that person or other riders.

Like many water parks and attractions across the United States, regulations regarding loose articles and medical assistance devices are enforced to ensure the safety of each guest. Water slides require a very smooth surface to operate properly. Any sort of abrasion or damage has the potential to cause injury to riders, which is why swimwear with exposed metal ornamentation, casts, certain braces, prosthetic devices, and any other loose article that could create a scratch or sharp edge in the surface of the slide are not permitted.

We never want to refuse our guests the opportunity to enjoy our attractions, but we must also always follow industry practices to ensure the safety of all riders. To avoid any confusion or heartache in the future, we will strive to make sure this is communicated better in advance by adding the restrictions to our website and ride signage. We deeply regret any disappointment caused to our guests due to our Ride Admission Policy. Again, our first priority is guest safety and our mission is to provide the best experience possible for all.
