

## Pennsylvania

Interviews with $\mathbf{1 , 0 3 2}$ adult Pennsylvanians conducted by telephone by ORC International on September 20-25, 2016. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points.

The Pennsylvania sample also includes 895 interviews among registered voters (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points) and 771 interviews among likely voters (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points).

In Pennsylvania, 532 interviews were conducted among landline respondents and 500 interviews among cell phone respondents.

## METHODOLOGY

A total of 1,032 Pennsylvania adults were interviewed by telephone statewide by live interviewers calling both landline and cellphones. All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect statewide Census figures for gender, race, age, education and region of the state.

This sample includes 532 interviews among landline respondents and 500 interviews among cell phone respondents.
Respondents were asked questions about whether they are registered to vote, their likelihood of voting, past voting behavior, and interest in the campaign. Based on the answers to those questions, 771 respondents were classified as likely voters. Among those likely voters, $38 \%$ described themselves as Democrats, $31 \%$ described themselves as Republicans and $31 \%$ described themselves as independents or members of another party. For the sample of registered voters, $49 \%$ said they were registered as Democrats, $37 \%$ registered as Republicans, $13 \%$ registered with no party and $1 \%$ with another party.

The Pennsylvania regions are composed of the following counties: the "Philadelphia" region is composed of Philadelphia county; the "Philadelphia Suburbs" region is composed of Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery counties; the "Northeast" region is composed of Berks, Bradford, Carbon, Columbia, Lackawanna, Lehigh, Luzerne, Monroe, Northampton, Pike, Schuylkill, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Wayne, and Wyoming counties; the "Central" region is composed of Adams, Bedford, Blair, Cameron, Centre, Clearfield, Clinton, Cumberland, Dauphin, Elk, Franklin, Fulton, Huntingdon, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lycoming, McKean, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Potter, Snyder, Tioga, Union and York counties and the "West" region is composed of Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Cambria, Clarion, Crawford, Erie, Fayette, Forest, Greene, Indiana, Jefferson, Lawrence, Mercer, Somerset, Venango, Warren, Washington and Westmoreland counties.

Crosstabs on the following pages only include results for subgroups with enough unweighted cases to produce a sampling error of +/- 8.5 percentage points or less. Some subgroups represent too small a share of the population of Pennsylvania to produce crosstabs with an acceptable sampling error. Interviews were conducted among these subgroups but results for groups with a sampling error larger than $+/-8.5$ percentage points are not displayed.
