<u>Inspector General Opens Investigation of Alleged Profiling by the</u> Transportation Security Administration.

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Office of Inspector General (OIG) opened its investigation into an allegation of profiling by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA).

OIG initiated the investigation amid a TSA employee's complaint. The employee alleged that his supervisor advised him to treat members of the Somali community differently from others who visit the Minneapolis TSA office.

The OIG will conduct its investigation and publish a public report, as appropriate.
